

Acorn Club Cookie Policy



This cookie policy applies to your use of AcornClub.com ("the Website") owned and operated by Acorn Mobility Services Limited ("Acorn", "us", "we"), a company registered in England and Wales with the company number 2593771. The policy explains what cookies are, how we use them, and with whom they are shared.

Cookies are small text files that are downloaded to your computer or mobile device when you visit the Website. Your browser sends those cookies back to the Website every time you visit the Website again, so that the Website can recognise you.

Cookies can have many different uses but within the Website, we use only cookies known as Essential cookies or Strictly Necessary cookies.

Essential/Strictly Necessary cookies are those that are required to enable you to move around the Website. Without the use of these cookies, parts of the Website would not function.

For example, without Essential/Strictly Necessary cookies, you would not remain logged in during your visit to the Website and you may be required to log in afresh on every page that you navigate to.

Similarly, when you add an item to your shopping cart, Essential/Strictly Necessary cookies make sure that the item is still in the cart when you arrive at the checkout. The cookies also allow us to verify your details when you place an order and when we process payment.

You have the option to opt-out of these (and all other) cookies by changing the settings on your browser under the 'Cookie Preferences' tab.

Please note, however, that the Website may not work correctly (or at all) if you change certain preferences. In particular, Essential/Strictly Necessary cookies are, as explained above and as suggested by their name, essential in order for the Website to function fully or as intended. We use these cookies to ensure basic functionalities and security features of the Website.

The use of these Essential/Strictly Necessary cookies is not shared with any third-parties.

Essential/Strictly Necessary cookies in use on the Website:

PHPSESSID	Necessary	This cookie is native to PHP applications. The cookie is used to store and identify a user's unique session ID for the purpose of managing user sessions on the website. The cookie is a session cookie and is deleted when all the browser windows are closed.	session
